Sector Partnerships

Sector partnerships are increasingly recognized as an effective method for aligning education, economic, and workforce development systems to address industry-identified labor market needs. The federal Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA), which replaces the Workforce Investment Act, shifts from an "employment first" strategy to one that emphasizes credential attainment through the use of sector partnerships and career pathways.
