








Detroit's Population (1900 - 2020)



















You Can in Michigan Rallies

- 92% of respondents said they were more likely to take a job and stay in the state
- 87% of participants reported an increased awareness about opportunities to live, work and play in Detroit, Grand Rapids and Flint.
