- ✓ *Collaborate with the ND Student Association to promote the adoption of OER textbooks for students within NDUS institutions.*
- ✓ *Provide easy access to students when searching for courses using OER textbooks.*
- ✓ *Maximize the strengths of the unified system in supporting low cost/no cost textbooks.*
- ✓ *Development of a system-wide new alternative math pathway (Mathematics in Society) utilizing OER resources.*



RECENT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- ✓ *In 2023, NDUS disbursed \$96,500 to support faculty to integrate, edit, and develop OER textbooks for students.*
- ✓ *NDUS modified the student information system class search to display courses using OER textbooks.*
- ✓ *The SBHE developed a dashboard to monitor the adoption of low cost/no cost textbooks.*

- ✓ *Continue to increase the amount of OER courses identified in the student information system.*
- ✓ *Collaborate with bookstore and library staff and faculty to identify OER textbooks and promote the benefits of OERs for students.*
