# With the anticipation of the delayed opening, changes in the form process and potential glitches, MCAN designed a proactive support strategy.

July 2023

- MCAN invited to attend NCAN national FAFSA training in Washington, D.C.
- MCAN convened and hosted a state team to attend and support statewide strategy.

Sept. 2023

- MCAN launched new Certified FAFSA Specialist Program.
- Partnered with uAspire to host BetterFAFSA training series. Over 750 sign up, over 600 in trainings.
- Assisted MDE in development and execution of the FAFSA Challenge Grant including strategy development, all HS outreach and support.

Oct 2023 -Jan 2024 • Hosted Certified FAFSA Specialist Training Series

Feb. 2024

- Created and shared FAFSA Support list aimed to provide additional staffing support for FAFSA completion efforts







# FAFSA Completion Initiatives - Community

- Local College Access Networks (LCAN):
  - Aim to increase college attainment using a framework known as Collective Impact within their communities
  - Each LCAN must have a FAFSA completion component/plan



# FAFSA Completion Initiatives - Counselors

- Course to College Network
  - Statewide network of school counselors dedicated to increasing the collegegoing culture in their schools
    - We provide: weekly network calls, resources & tools, incentives, & assistance with events
    - We encourage each partner school to set FAFSA goal
- FAFSA Certification training provided by Iowa College Access Network(ICAN)
  - Provide FAFSA training to all partner schools
- Texting
  - Offer 1:1 texting to counselors with college info, deadlines, changes, reminders & ability to ask questions

Automated, weekly reports sent to each high school in the state

- Provides school completion rate, with previous year comparisons for goal tracking
- Lists not filed students
- Lists not completed students with error description
- Includes students selected for verification



Tailgating events will be held around the state to promote and assist in FAFSA completion.






