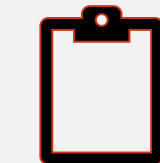

5. Save the Excel sheet as a Comma Separated Value or CSV file. This option shows as a drop-down in Excel for saving a file. Any CSV format on the list will work.
6. Return to the exporting page on GCQ. Click the "browse files to export"; this will take you back to your file listing where you can select the CSV file and double-click or select.
7. The file will automatically transfer the information to your university's database.
8. Return to your "Courses" on the left-hand border menu and verify a sample of the courses listed from your CSV file.
9. Done.
