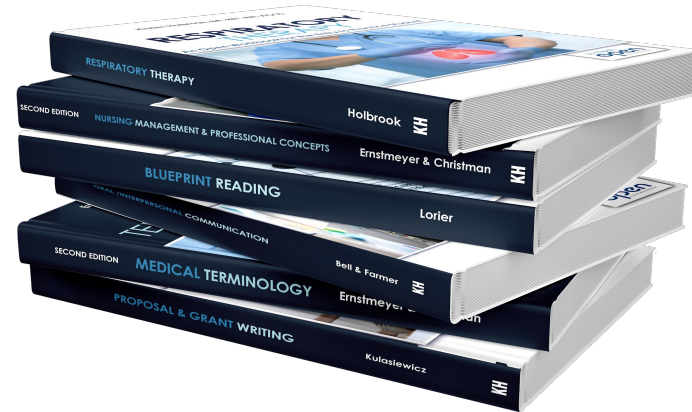
WisTech Background

- Mission to create and share free, interactive open content for Wisconsin technical college students
- Grew out of Open RN to create nursing resources
- Shaped by student advocacy to lower costs and expand access
- Resources now span multiple fields and are used internationally
- Funding sources include federal, state, private grants; also includes royalties for sustainability



WisTech Process

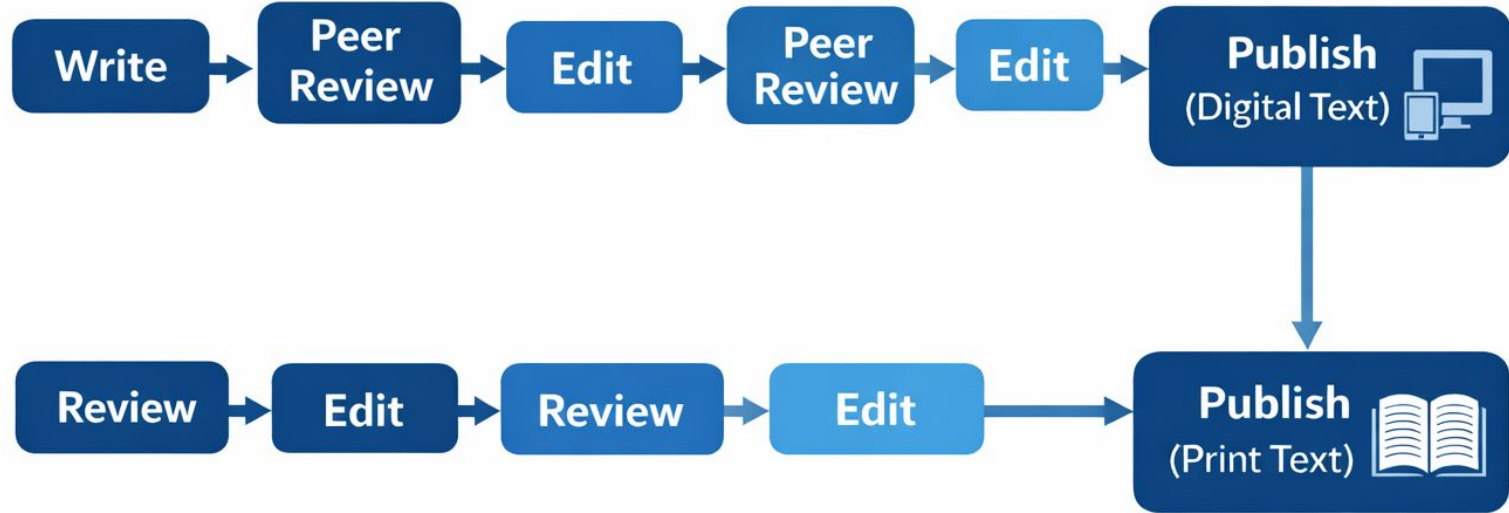
- Project ideas submitted by Wisconsin faculty
- Approval process includes budgetary, steering committee, and state
- Paid editor/s identified
- Paid authors, chapter and peer reviewers solicited through colleges



Project Team Support

- Project team communicates with the 16 technical colleges, WTCS System office, Universities of Wisconsin, K-12, and/or industry partners/organizations
- Includes project coordination, instructional design, library, graphics, accessibility, and copy-editing supports for editors and authors
- Maintains a centralized, shared OER repository

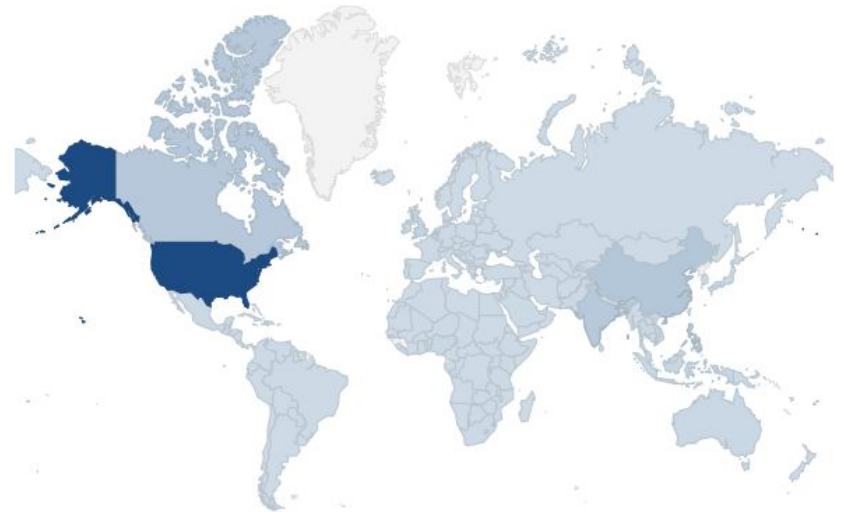

Origins: Teacher Education OTP Project

- ★ Open Textbook Pilot (OTP) grant from Department of Education
 - Create Teacher Education courses that could be used in any U.S. state
 - Infuse culturally responsive pedagogies
 - Ensure accessibility, quality
 - Prioritize personalization, user experience
- ★ Resulting modular, aligned approach
 - OER not a textbook or a course, but a content collection
 - Filterable selection for building LEGO style

The following schools offer one or more Z-degrees:



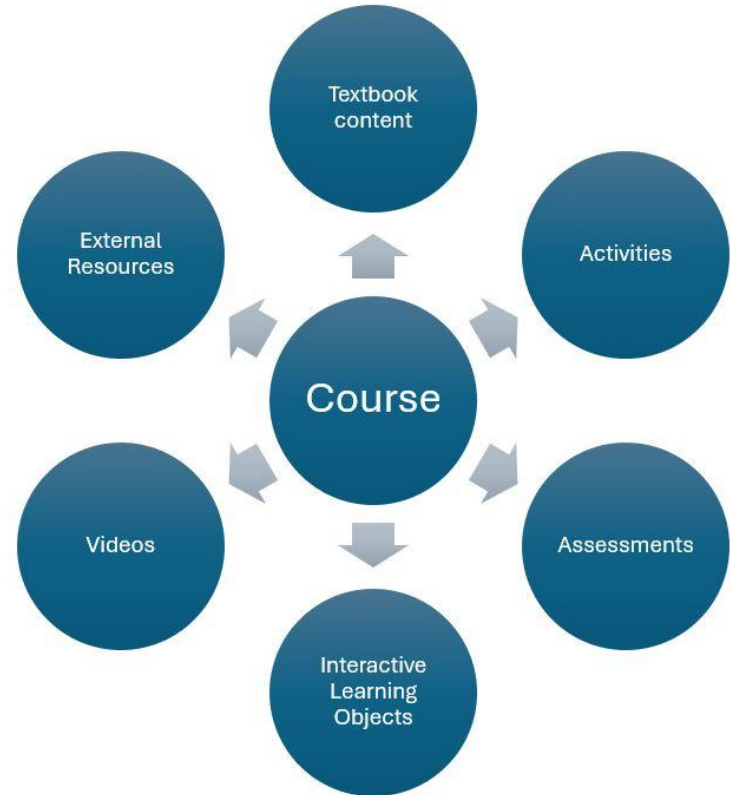

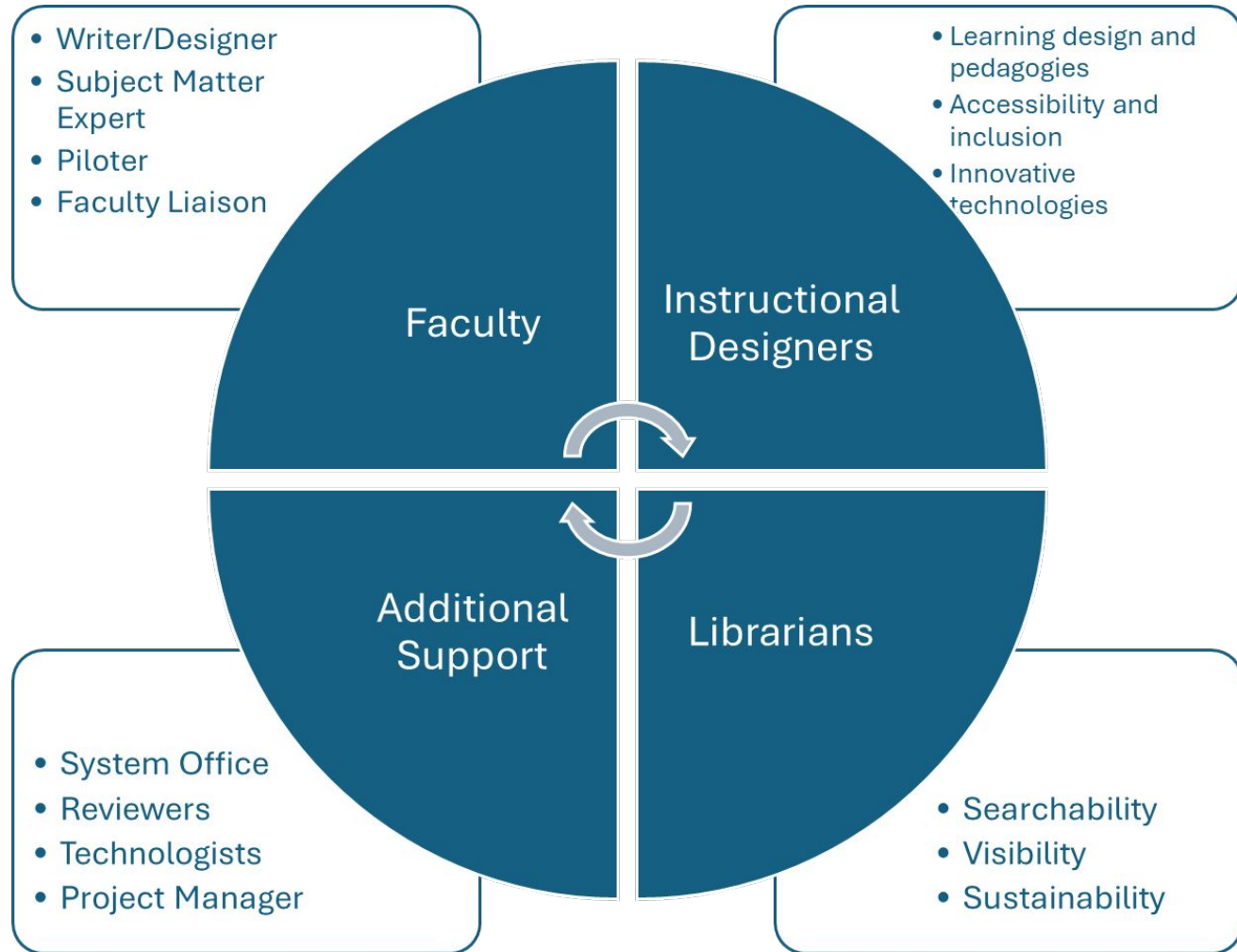

Initiative

- ★ **Unique Design**
 - OER as modular, aligned components (not a textbook)
 - Quality standards for inclusive and effective learning
- ★ **Unique Process**
 - Adapt and create (not adopt and curate)
 - Faculty partners guided by system office team
 - Ancillary emphasis (filterable buffet)
- ★ **Unique Focus**
 - Repository of OER components in service to Z-Degree, Transfer Pathways, and Equity 2030
 - LEGO-style course-building supports Academic Freedom, unique learning needs
- ★ **Multi-year project**
