MHEC leverages the knowledge and expertise of postsecondary leaders to generate collaborative solutions to challenges in higher education.

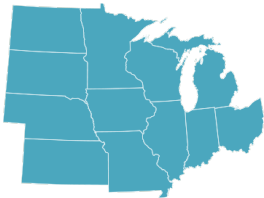

About the Compact



MHEC was established in the early 1990s through the enactment of legislation recommended by the Midwestern Legislative Conference of The Council of State Governments. MHEC is funded by member state commitments, program income, and foundation grants. Member states are Illinois, Indiana, Iowa, Kansas, Michigan, Minnesota, Missouri, Nebraska, North Dakota, Ohio, South Dakota, and Wisconsin. Michigan enacted authorizing legislation in 1990 to join MHEC.

How MHEC Benefits Michigan

Michigan received a 169-fold return on its MHEC membership commitment of \$115,000 in 2024-2025.

New Upcoming Savings & Financial Opportunities

- Each member state is eligible for a Strategic Impact and Innovation Grant of up to \$250,000 over two years from MHEC to advance innovative ideas and solutions in higher education. In early April 2026, MHEC awarded a multi-partner collaborative in Michigan a \$250,000 grant to bolster the state’s efforts to award credit for prior learning and ensure seamless pathways from work experience to bachelor’s degree completion in applied programs.
- MHEC will produce an estimated \$1.9 million in savings for the region in 2025-26 on student health insurance due to participation growth in a contract with UnitedHealthCare – StudentResources. One Michigan institution currently participates in MHEC’s contract: Oakland University.

Additional Savings for Michigan Students & Families

The Midwest Student Exchange Program (MSEP) has helped students and families save millions of dollars by making it more affordable for non-resident students to attend out-of-state colleges and universities. This program is currently being reviewed in response to changes in tuition reciprocity practices across the region.



Michigan Engagement with MHEC Policy Initiatives & Capacity-Building Opportunities

Open Educational Resources (OER)	MHEC provided a \$10,000 grant to Midwest Collaborative for Library Services to support the Michigan OER conference and a Michigan OER leadership virtual summit, as well as to migrate the MCCA OER Commons into the MDE GoOpen Michigan platform. Five Michigan OER leaders attended MHEC's OER Summit.
Dual Enrollment	Twelve Michigan higher education leaders participated in MHEC's July State Policy Workshop to advance dual enrollment efforts in the state. MHEC is also supporting the action planning related to the newly mandated dual enrollment taskforce.
Access & Affordability	Leaders from numerous Michigan state agencies, colleges and universities, nonprofits organizations, philanthropy, and more attended MHEC's FAFSA Summit and other webinars to address issues and opportunities related to college access and affordability.
Technologies Community	Aric Kirkland from Eastern Michigan University is vice chair of the Technologies Community Executive Committee. Eight other higher education tech leaders actively participate in the Technologies Community.

MHEC's policy and research team provided a detailed report in response to requests from Michigan higher education leaders on the topic of measurement of return on investment for higher education.

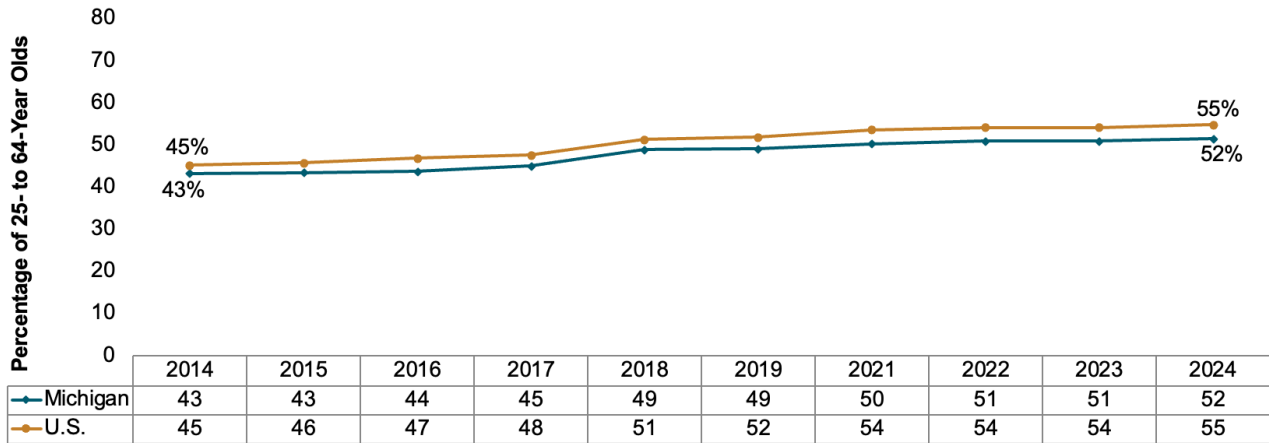

ATTAINMENT: Michigan’s postsecondary attainment rate has increased over the past decade. About 52% of Michiganders have a postsecondary certificate or higher, compared to 55% nationally.

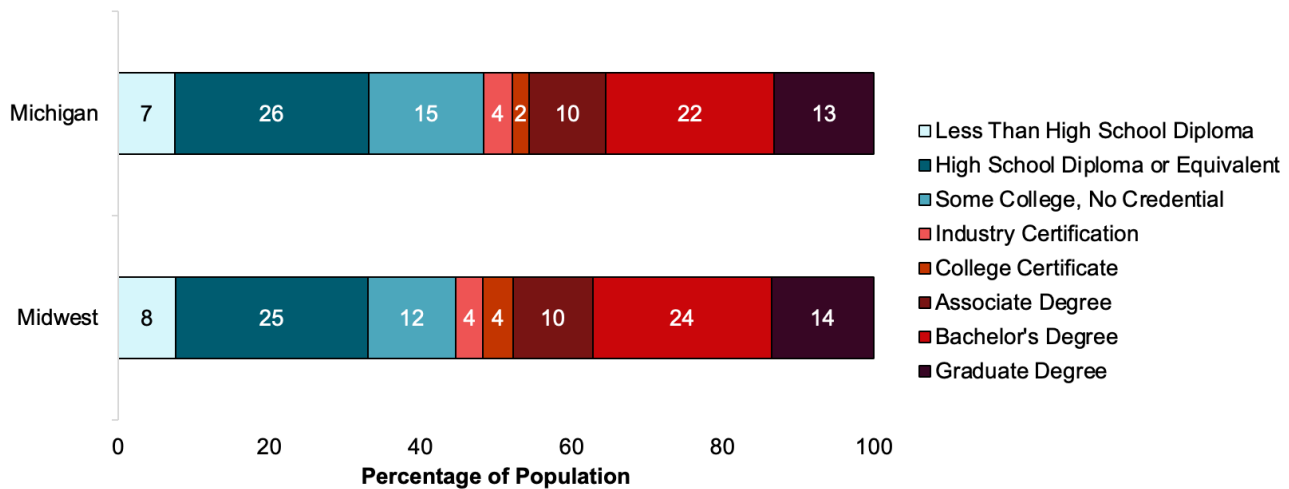
Percentage of 25- to 64-Year-Olds in Michigan Who Have Attained a Postsecondary Credential

ATTAINMENT: Michigan residents have attained various types of postsecondary credentials, ranging from industry certifications and college certificates to bachelor’s and graduate degrees; 48% of residents do not have a credential beyond high school.

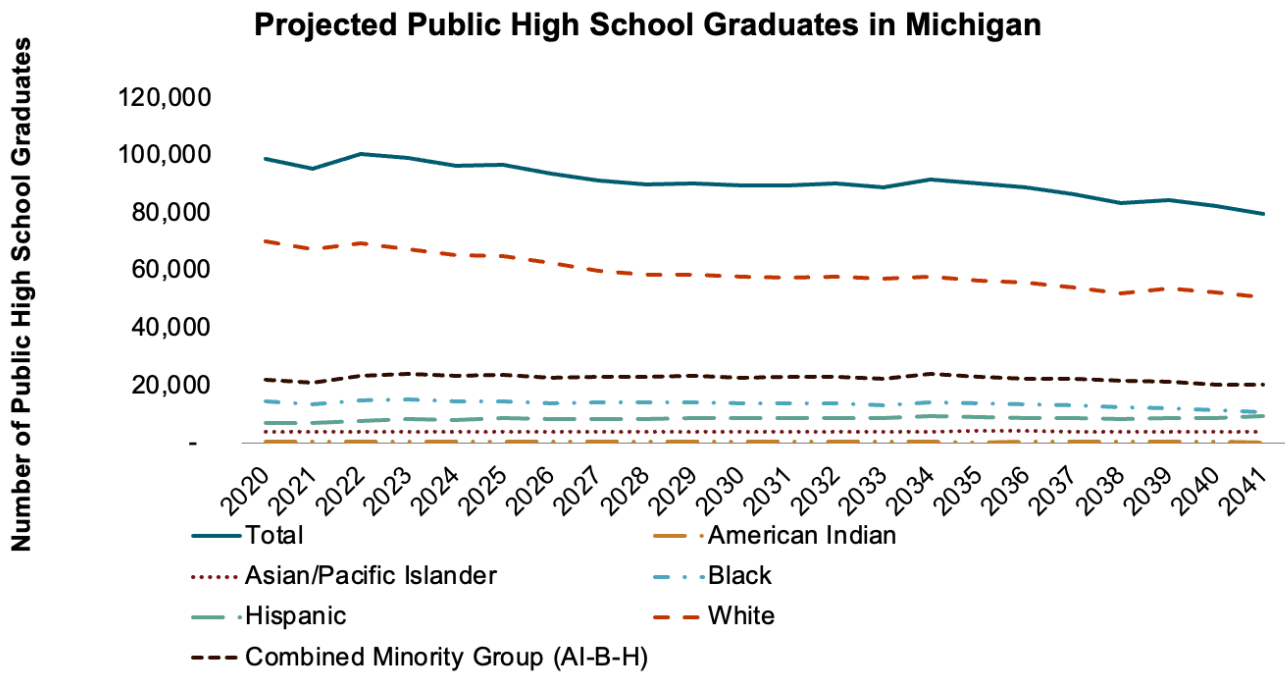
Educational Attainment Distribution of Michigan Residents Ages 25-64, 2024

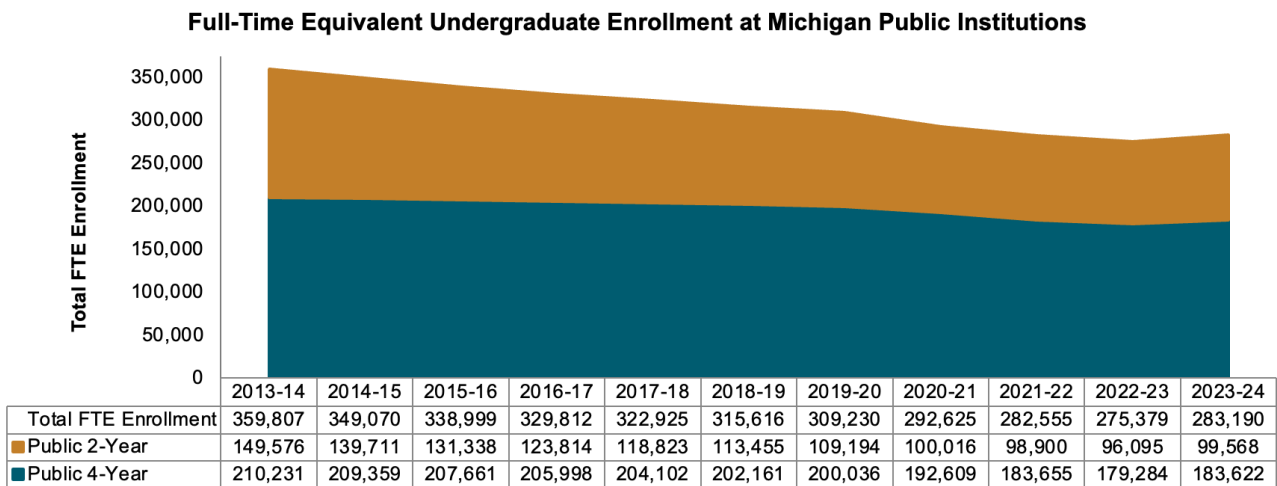

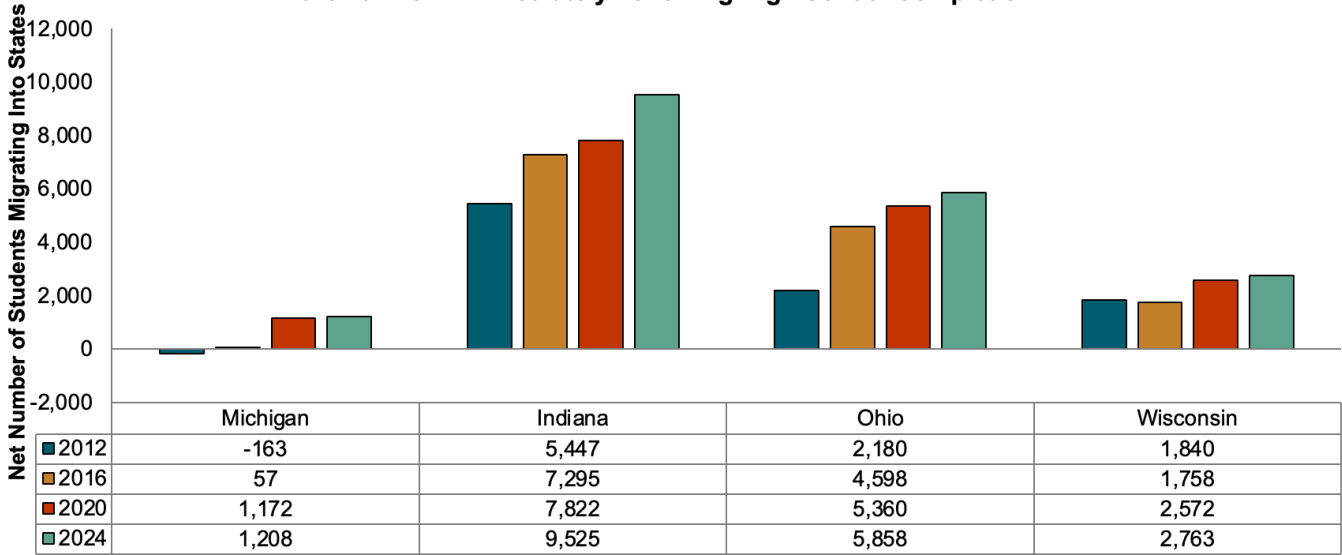
ENROLLMENT: Undergraduate enrollment has declined at public two- and four-year institutions in Michigan over the past decade but started to increase in 2023-24.

MIGRATION: More students migrate into Michigan than migrate out.

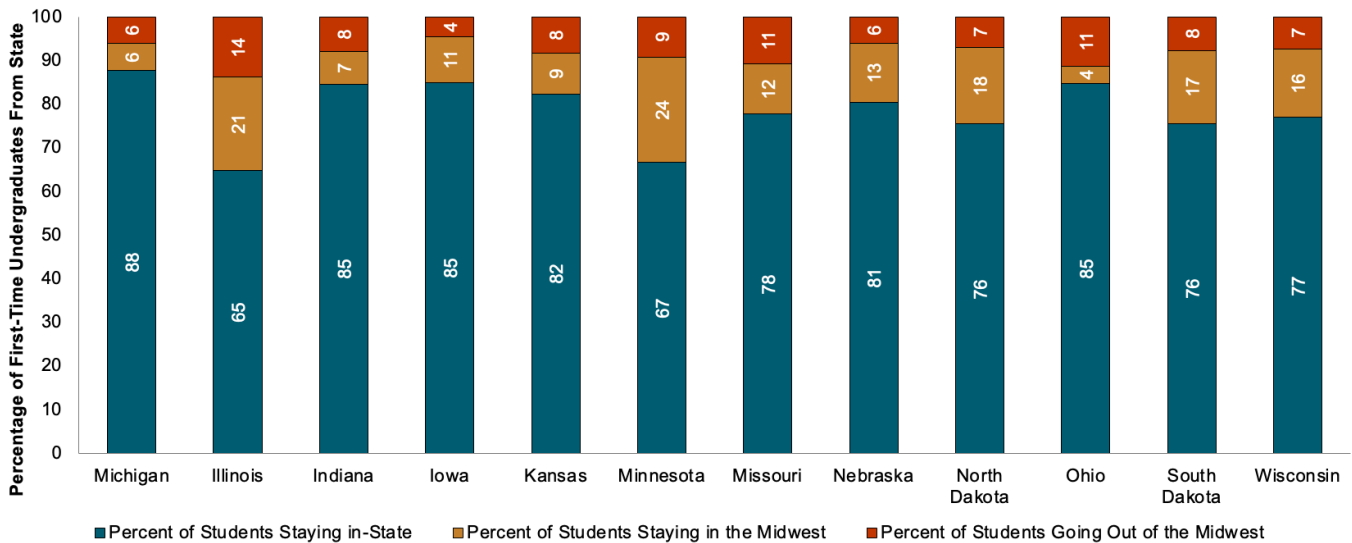
Net In-Migration of High School Graduates Who Enrolled in a Postsecondary Institution in the Fall Term Immediately Following High School Completion

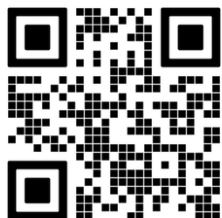
